

Keratoconus 101

Educate yourself

- · Keratoconus means "cone-shaped cornea"
- . 1 in 500 people suffer from Keraroconus
- A bulge appears on the cornea from an unknown cause
- · The cornea becomes very thin

Symptoms

Look out for the following symptoms

- Glares
- · Light sensitivity
- · Change in prescription
- · Night vision decreases
- Eye irritation
- · Mildly blurred or distorted vision
- · Frequent prescription change
- · Increased astigmatism or nearsightedness





Treatments

There are many alternatives to a cornea transplant

- Holcomb C3-R (Crosslinking) -is a 30 minute cornea strenghtening and stablization treatment
- Contacts -6 different types to address level of Keratoconus
- CK-is a 8 minute minimally invasive treatment to reduce astigmatism
- Intacs- tiny clear circle that goes on the cornea



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
